



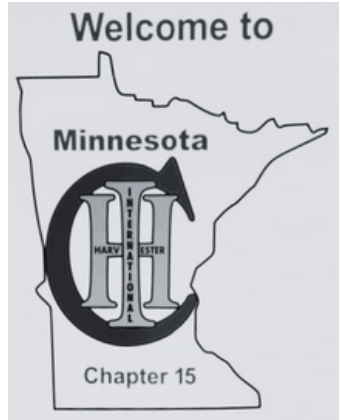

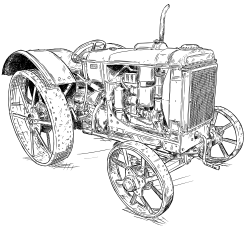

The spring membership mtg was held at Randy & Terri VanWyhe shop in Pine Island, Mn. Sat. May 18th. A good turn out of people.

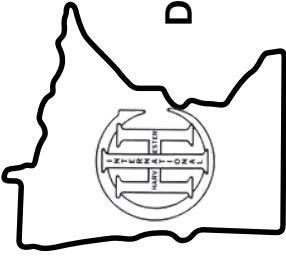
